Notes of cherry tobacco and plums evoke cherished childhood memories.

A Bordeaux inspired blend in memory of our family matriarch; Granny Kay.

Terroir;

Bonnievale is a small district of Robertson wine Valley, and is defiantly different in terroir from Robertson itself. Though we have planted all six Bordeaux cultivars on Doornbosch this vintage only contain four of the 6. The Merlot and Cabernet Franc is planted on deep red clay soils, a pocket we felt would be perfect to create deep intense fruit flavours with row directions North east to south west to optimise sunlight hours and the Cabernet Sauvignon and Carménère is planted on the shale 'koppies' of the farm. On these two blocks the row directions are south east to south west to protect against the strong south east wind in summer. The shale also helps to maintain perfect balance between vegetation and the bunch formations.
